1. Chief Base Manager

Qualifications:

Graduate in any field

Qualifications & Experience

Retired from active command within last 3 years in leadership role who has operated in Chardham shuttle operations.

Should have held CHPL during flying.

Roles & Responsibilities:

- ❖ Flight Oversight & Mentorship
 - Review and approve daily sortie plans, weather assessments, and VFR/IFR considerations.
 - Provide one-on-one coaching to pilots on mountain flying techniques and decision-making.
- ❖ Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) Management
 - Maintain and update flight-ops manuals, checklists, and emergency procedures in line with DGCA/UCADA directives.
 - Lead quarterly SOP review meetings and incorporate lessons from incident investigations.
- ❖ Safety & Regulatory Liaison
 - Act as primary point of contact for DGCA/UCADA audits related to pilot training and currency.
 - Conduct pre-flight safety briefings, simulate in-flight emergency scenarios, and ensure corrective-action follow-up.
- ❖ Crew Scheduling & Currency Tracking
 - Oversee pilot rostering to guarantee legal duty-time limits, rest periods, and high-altitude acclimatization.
 - Monitor individual pilot currency on mountain routes, specialized equipment, and mandatory refresher checks.
- ❖ Flight-Data Review & Quality Assurance
 - Analyze flight-recorder trends (fuel consumption, engine parameters, altitude profiles) for continuous improvement.
 - Verify post-flight logs for deviations, write up pilot performance debriefs, and recommend remedial training.
- ❖ Emergency Response Leadership
 - Serve as Incident Commander for in-flight or ground emergencies until command is transferred.
 - Coordinate rescue-helicopter call-outs and liaise with NDRF/army aviation units when required.

Experience:

Roles & Responsibilities:

- Plan and oversee daily flight schedules, VFR briefings, load & weight-balance checks, and crew rostering in line with DGCA/UCADA duty-time limits
- Implement and monitor the Safety Management System by conducting hazard assessments, lead daily safety briefings, investigate incidents, and track corrective actions
- Inspect and maintain helipad infrastructure (FATO/TLOF surfaces, firefighting gear) and verify continuous operation of weather-camera/CCTV feeds
- Manage passenger manifests and IRCTC booking compliance and coordinate priority group boarding and emergency evacuation procedures.
- Liaise with DGCA, local administration, NDRF/army/police during inspections, disaster-relief operations, and monsoon contingencies.
- Produce daily Situation Reports and monthly performance analyses (flight counts, delays, safety metrics).
- Enforce acclimatization protocols and medical-fitness screenings.
- Plan and execute quarterly fire drills, first-aid and mass casualty simulations and act as on site Incident Commander.

Roles & Responsibilities:

- ❖ Pilot Documentation Audit
 - Verify validity of pilot licenses, ratings, medical certificates, and currency endorsements before each duty roster.
 - Cross-check simulator and route-familiarization training records, ensuring high-altitude endorsements are current.
- ❖ Helicopter Documentation Control
 - Review aircraft airworthiness certificates, maintenance-release forms, defect logs, and compliance with airworthiness directives.
 - Ensure up-to-date records of checks, component life-limits, and service-bulletins are filed per DGCA/UCADA norms.
- ❖ General Tarmac & Facility Inspection
 - Conduct pre-shift walk-arounds of FATO/TLOF areas, taxi lanes, aprons, , surface damage, and drainage issues.
 - Inspect ground-handling gear (chocks, tie-downs, refuelers), fire-fighting equipment, windsocks, and backup-power units.
- ❖ Maintenance Coordination Support
 - Liaise with service providers to schedule routine servicing and expedite rectification of any defects identified during inspections.
 - Track open maintenance items and verify clearance entries before signing off for flight release.
- ❖ Compliance Reporting & Record-Keeping

Roles & Responsibilities:

- ❖ Weather Data Collection & Analysis
 - Retrieve and interpret data from IMD bulletins, satellite imagery, radar feeds, and on-site AWS (temperature, pressure, wind, humidity).
 - Maintain and calibrate ground sensors—anemometers, ceilometers, barographs—at each helibase.
- ❖ Forecasting & Briefing
 - Produce and disseminate daily VFR flight-weather briefs, highlighting visibility, cloud ceilings, wind shear, and turbulence risks.
 - Issue “go/no-go” advisories and rolling updates during flight windows, especially at dawn and dusk.
- ❖ Real-Time Monitoring & Alerts
 - Monitor developing hazards—thunderstorms, heavy precipitation, icing, or monsoon squalls—and relay immediate warnings to the base manager and flight coordination.
 - Use radio and mobile channels to push urgent weather changes directly to pilots and operations staff.
- ❖ Flight-Safety Liaison
 - Advise the Assistant Manager – Operations on optimum slot timing based on weather windows, minimizing cancellations and delays.
 - Coordinate with Incident Commander and emergency teams when weather-driven diversions or evacuations are required.
- ❖ Record-Keeping & Reporting
 - Log all weather observations, forecasts, and advisories in the operations database for regulatory audits (DGCA/UCADA) and post-season analysis.
 - Generate weekly meteorological trend reports to support capacity planning and risk-mitigation strategies.

5. Assistant Manager -Operations

Qualifications:

Bachelor's degree in Aviation Management/ Aeronautical Engineering/ or related field

Experience:

- Minimum 05 years experience in in helicopter operations or airside coordination, preferably in high-tempo or mountain environments.
- Hands-on experience with VFR flight planning, crew rostering, and slot-management procedures
- Proven ability to manage weight-and-balance checks, passenger manifests, and emergency-evacuation protocols

Roles & Responsibilities:

- ❖ Flight Coordination
 - Verify aircraft dispatch readiness by confirming crew reports, weight-and-balance sheets, and pre-flight inspections.
 - Sequence and prioritize flights based on passenger load, weather windows, and emergency requests.
 - Coordinate with pilots to finalize departure clearances and ensure compliance with VFR protocols.
 - Update live flight manifests and liaise with ground handling to stage baggage.
- ❖ Slot Control
 - Allocate helipad take-off and landing slots in the slot-management system, aligning with peak-period capacity.
 - Monitor real-time slot occupancy, flagging potential conflicts or bottlenecks.
 - Reassign or swap slots swiftly when delays, mechanical holds, or rescue sorties arise.
 - Maintain a rolling log of slot changes and justification for audit and analysis.
- ❖ Base Manager Communication
 - Deliver concise updates on flight statuses, weather holds, and ground-equipment availability.
 - Escalate critical issues—technical snags, runway obstruction, crew shortages—with proposed mitigation steps.
 - Request additional resources (ground crew, fuel trucks, maintenance teams) based on shifting operational needs.
 - Document all directives and approvals in the shift handover log.
- ❖ Flight Follow-Up & Slot Monitoring
 - Track each sortie from “wheels up” through approach and landing, confirming adherence to assigned slots.
 - Log deviations (early/late arrivals) and coordinate with slot control to adjust subsequent departures.
 - Initiate expedited turnarounds by alerting ground teams to prepare heliramp, refueling, and boarding.
 - Compile end-of-shift slot-utilization and deviation reports for trend analysis.
- ❖ Mobile Coordination
 - Maintain continuous radio and mobile-telephony connectivity with pilots, base leadership, and remote crews.
 - Broadcast urgent advisories weather updates, slot revisions, emergency procedures—to all stakeholders.

- Trigger mobile alerts to mobilize standby crews, medical teams, or rescue units as situations demand.
 - Ensure backup communication channels (satellite phone, handheld radio) are tested and ready.

Roles & Responsibilities:

- Day-to-day PTB management including layout/space allocation, passenger flow optimisation, terminal signage, seating and amenities, cleanliness, accessibility services, and coordination of terminal facilities with internal teams and contractors.
- Supervise daily PTB check-in counters, boarding gates, arrival halls, transfer desks and passenger assistance points.
- Lead and coach operator staff (check-in agents, gate agents, customer service assistants, porters, cleaners) rostering, performance reviews, training, and attendance.
- Ensure smooth passenger flow during peak periods and implement queue management strategies; manage special assistance and VIP handling.
- Coordinate with operator, contractors & security to resolve operational issues and align on PTB usage.
- Monitor and enforce terminal safety, security and regulatory compliance (DGCA/BCAS or local authority standards).
- Handle passenger irregularities and complaints lead incident response during disruptions (delays, diversions, emergency evacuations).
- Maintain accurate logs, shift handovers, and operational reports; prepare daily/weekly performance dashboards and incident reports.
- Control counter allocation, boarding bridges, signage, special assistance equipment and public address coordination.
- Lead special projects for process improvements, passenger experience initiatives and any PTB upgrades.

Roles & Responsibilities:

- ❖ VHF Communication Management
 - Maintain continuous VHF contact with airborne helicopters during arrival, departure, and transit phases.
 - Relay landing clearance, base status, and dynamic weather updates to pilots clearly and promptly.
 - Log all radio transmissions and flight-related messages per UCADA/DGCA protocols.
- ❖ Mobile Coordination
 - Use dedicated mobile lines/WhatsApp groups to share flight updates, delays, and emergency alerts with operators and support teams.
 - Provide mobile-based backup communication during VHF signal fluctuations or outages.
 - Track ETA/ETD of each sortie and ensure the base manager is informed of any changes.
- ❖ Slot & Movement Monitoring
 - Coordinate with flight slot control team to regulate movements and avoid congestion at helipads.
 - Inform base personnel and AM-Ops about delays, diversions, or early arrivals.
- ❖ Emergency Support Communication
 - Act as point-of-contact during emergencies—ensuring smooth relay of distress calls, activation of incident command chain, and base alerts.
 - Ensure power backups and alternate communication tools are functional during contingency operations.
- ❖ Documentation & Reporting
 - Maintain a logbook of daily transmissions, flight movement data, and incident summaries.
